### Maintenance News

During maintenance of the towplane, extensive rust damage was discovered in the rudder and horizontal stabilizers. Maintenance Officer Jim Miles with a crew of volunteers has removed the plane's tail feathers, and we write they are being evaluated by an experienced welder to determine their reparability. As a consequence, there will be **No Flying** April 25-26, and it's uncertain as to when the towplane will be back in service. In the interim, the Maintenance Officer will alert the cognizant Duty Officer as to when the ship will
